 'Has revitalised its curriculum over recent years. Starting in the early years, the school has purposefully designed pupils' learning to build well from year to year in all subjects. Staff make effective checks to find out what pupils have remembered and understood. They use this information well to quickly spot and address pupils misconceptions and adapt future teaching. In these subjects pupils have frequent opportunities to revisit earlier learning so that they do not forget. They recall knowledge fluently as a result' – OFSTED Oct 2023

• At the beginning of each half term, children in Years 1 to 6 are set Homework tasks, as well as spellings for children in Years 3 to 6. These are communicated to parents via email/MCAS App and uploaded to Showbie. Through our Digital Strategy, children in Years 1 to 6 take their iPads home allowing them to access a range of Apps to support their learning further.

88% of parents feel the school make sure pupils are well behaved and are aware of the school's Behaviour Policy

 All parents/carers are issued with a copy of the schools Behaviour Policy when their child starts at St. Bede, and they agree to support the school in the implementation of this policy. The policy is also available to view on our website and is reviewed each year. All behavioural issues are dealt with in accordance with this policy. If you wish to discuss anything, please make an appointment via the school office to meet with your child's class teacher. Pupils know exactly how staff expect them to behave. They follow the school 'seven Ss' by moving around the building sensibly and with a ready smile. In this way pupils help to create a quiet and orderly environment. Pupils understand that they are expected to give their best in lessons. They rise to the schools high expectations. They listen attentively and they show respect to their teachers and to each other. Pupils show care and compassion for others. They display positive attitudes for learning and are keen to do well – OFSTED Oct 2023.

• As per our Complaints procedure we take all concerns raised by parents seriously and endeavour to deal with these as soon as possible. 88% of parents feel they receive information from the school about their child's progress.

• The school holds Parents Evenings in the autumn and spring terms, and an End of Year written report at the end of the summer term. This is the legal requirement for all schools.

78% of parents feel the school makes them aware of what their child will learn during the year.

- At the end of each school year, all parents/carers are invited to attend a face-to face 'Meet the Teacher' meeting, where information is shared about the forthcoming academic year. We are aware not all parents can attend these meetings therefore this information is emailed out and is also available on our website. Long term plans are also be found on the school website and are shared in the Transition Passports that children bring home after their 'moving-up day'.
- The school involves parents and carers in their children's education effectively OFSTED Oct 2023

79% of parents feel the school supports their child's wider development.

• The schools programme to support pupils' personal development is well thought out. Pupils embrace the wide range of experiences on offer to them. These opportunities include trips and visits to places of artistic and cultural significance such as galleries and museums -OFSTED Oct 2023.

88% of parents feel their child can take part in clubs and activities.

 We aim to enrich the education of the children by providing a range of after school activities, and we recently launched a new model for these activities. Every child in school is invited to attend at least one Club over the academic year. These Clubs are themed around aspirations for the future and children will receive a badge for attending the Club. Badges can be collected as the children move through school, like how badges are collected at Scouts/Guides etc. There is no cost for any of these Clubs.

91% of parents feel there is a good range of subjects available to their child at St. Bede.

• We are proud to offer children in Years 1 to 6 a bespoke curriculum that not only inspires learning but develops skills, knowledge and understanding to equip them for later life. The implementation of our curriculum encourages every pupil to reach their full potential through quality first teaching of a broad, balanced, and sequential curriculum in subjects including: English, Maths, Science, Religious Education, Computing, Geography & History, Design Technology, Art & Design, Music, P.E., PSHRE and Modern Foreign Languages. In Early Years our philosophy focuses on child centred learning and the way children learn is defined by the characteristics of effective learning along with Prime (Personal. Social Emotional areas and Development: Communication and Language; Physical Development) and Specific areas (Literacy; Mathematics; Understanding the World; Expressive Arts and Design).
